Headland Middle School Tardy Policy

The morning tardy bell rings at 7:45am. If the student arrives at school after this time, they are tardy. A parent must come into the school and sign them in after 7:45. If the parent fails to sign them in, they will be called back to the school.

According to the Henry County Board of Education Code of learner conduct, tardiness is considered a Level 1 offense. The school's administration has the discretion to assign before school, after school, or Saturday detention for excessive tardiness.

Consequences of Excessive Unexcused Tardies:

- 3 Unexcused tardies result in 2 days of morning detention or 1 day after school
- 3 (6 total) more result in 4 days of morning or 2 days after school
- 3 (9 total) more result in 6 days of morning or 3 days after school
- 10 total unexcused tardies, students will be assigned 3 days in Alternative School
- 11 total result in 5 days of Alternative School
- 12 total result in 9 days of Alternative School

Morning detention will be 7:00am - 7:30am.

After school detention will be 2:45pm – 3:45pm.

These consequences will also apply if your learner has excessive tardies to class during the day.
