- CALCULATOR USE FOR SCANTRON (FORMERLY GLOBAL SCHOLAR) MID-YEAR ACADEMIC GROWTH ASSESSMENT ADMINISTRATION Parents, students are allowed, but not required, to use an approved calculator on Grades 6-8 Mathematics tests. Students are encouraged to use a personal calculator they are familiar with on the assessment. Bumpus will provide a basic four-function calculator for all students. However, your child might benefit from being able to use a higher functioning scientific calculator on the SCANTRON/GLOBAL SCHOLAR ASSESSMENT. These higher functioning calculators, such as the TI-30X IIS, can be found at most stores, and are as inexpensive as \$12.97. Students will have the opportunity to continue using scientific calculators in future math and science courses in high school. Remember, this is not a requirement. A basic four function calculator will be provided for all students, and students will also be prepared for its use.

- SCOLIOSIS SCREENING -Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup> Dear Parent: In accordance with Alabama law, Section 16-29-1, Code Alabama, 1975, our school will be conducting a free screening to detect adolescent scoliosis on Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup>. The school nurse will conduct the scoliosis screening program. The screening, which takes about one minute, is simple and not embarrassing. It involves a visual examination of the back while standing straight and bending over. Boys and girls will be screened separately. Scoliosis is a twisting, or curve of the spine which occurs in about 10% of the adolescent population and about 2 ½% will require some type of medical attention. The first sign of scoliosis is usually noticed between the ages of ten and fourteen. If any symptoms are detected for your child, you will be notified by letter. Please make sure your child wears a slip-on shirt or blouse on the screening day. Girls may wear a bathing suit top or bra which will remain on during the screening. If you wish for your child NOT to be screened please send notification in writing to the health room prior to the screening date. Thank you for you cooperation with the screening program. - HEALTH ROOM REMINDERS Parents here are a few reminders from the health room as we move forward through the cold and flu season. Please remember that if your child is absent with a fever (100 or greater) they CAN NOT return to school until they are fever free for 24 hours without using Tylenol or Advil. This includes NOT sending your child to school just to take a test. Keep in mind your child will not perform at his/her best when sick. This also exposes other students to a potentially contagious illness even during that short time they take a test. Our teachers are more than willing to work with your child on making up any missed tests/work after they return per school protocol. Also, if your child feels bad at school and notifies you via text or email please encourage them to visit the health room first before checking out. This allows the nurse to be aware of students who are sick and what illnesses are in the school. If your child is seen by a doctor and is diagnosed with flu make sure you call the health room at 439-2230 to report it. This is done for tracking purposes. We care for your child and want to keep them healthy while at school. Thank you for your cooperation in making this happen!
