- <u>HEALTH ROOM REMINDERS</u> Parents here are a few reminders from the health room as we move forward through the cold and flu season. Please remember that if your child is absent with a fever (100 or greater) they <u>CAN</u> <u>NOT</u> return to school until they are fever free for 24 hours without using Tylenol or Advil.</u> This includes NOT sending your child to school just to take a test. Keep in mind your child will not perform at his/her best when sick. This also exposes other students to a potentially contagious illness even during that short time they take a test. Our teachers are more than willing to work with your child on making up any missed tests/work after they return per school protocol. Also, if your child feels bad at school and notifies you via text or email please encourage them to visit the health room first before checking out. This allows the nurse to be aware of students who are sick and what illnesses are in the school. If your child is seen by a doctor and is diagnosed with flu make sure you call the health room at 439-2230 to report it. This is done for tracking purposes. We care for your child and want to keep them healthy while at school. Thank you for your cooperation in making this happen!
