Classroom Clips

<u>Kindergarten</u> - We are finishing up our unit on the farm just in time for our field trip!!! Please be sure to send your child's lunch in disposable bags, as we will not be able to cart around a whole bunch of lunch boxes. It will be hot and sunny, so please, as always, have your little one in tennis shoes. Also, you may want to apply sunscreen before they leave the house. If you are meeting us at the farm, please aim to be there about 9:00am! We can't wait!

1st Grade - We are nearing the end of the school year, but these 1st graders are still going strong and working hard to learn all they possibly can! We are solving all different types of addition and subtraction problems. We are using good reading strategies to unlock words we don't yet know. In writing we are working hard to "show, not tell" by focusing on tiny realistic details in our writing and using adjectives! It's great to be in 1st grade here at Rocky Ridge!

2nd Grade - 2ND GRADE - Last week consisted of many exciting events for our second graders. We attended our field trip to DeSoto Caverns to observe how the Earth changes over time. In addition, we actively participated in a Bricks for Kidz program where we used engineering skills to create spin art machines and race cars.

<u>3rd Grade</u> - We are so proud of our third graders for all their hard work on the ACT Aspire this week! We are looking forward to the upcoming Spring Fling on April 28th and hope to see you there.

<u>4th Grade</u> - The 4th graders have become student biologists! They are carefully observing the lifestyle, body structure, and behavior of fiddler crabs and African Dwarf frogs. Each day the students go to the science lab to observe these creatures and to understand their habitats. They have learned that fiddler crabs are crustaceans and are crepuscular! Ask any 4th grader and they'll fill you in!

They have also discovered ALGEBRA! Actually, they've been doing it and haven't even known it. Now, though, they are looking at what happens in situations where there is constant change. How many pennies accumulate in a jar after adding the same number each time? Can that situation be written mathematically? These and other exciting questions are being answered each day in 4th grade math classrooms!

All classes are reading some incredible books this spring that include unusual and interesting characters. In order to share these interesting characters, they are creating "Character Trading Cards" fashioned after sports trading cards with vital information about characters from their books. Once completed, they will have an opportunity to trade them with classmates and hopefully encourage others to try out their awesome novel for themselves!

5th Grade -We are continuing our learning in math about how to multiply and divide decimals before we progress to measurement and data analysis in preparation for sixth grade! In science, we are building vocabulary booklets and exploring the realm of space. Students are working on beefing up their reading stamina through chapter books and reading comprehension skills. In social studies, we are working on map skills and geography. Book fair is next week!
