LHS Safety Guidelines for Football Athletic Events

Safety is a top priority at Lanett High School. In an effort to ensure the safety of all attendees at our football games/sporting events, the following guidelines have been implemented:

- 1. <u>ALL children, ages 12 and under, must be accompanied by an adult chaperone (age 19 or older) at all times</u> while in attendance at the football game.
 - a. These attendees are expected to be seated in the stands with their adult chaperone and should be accompanied by their chaperone when visiting the concession stand and/or restrooms.
- 2. No one is allowed to sit on or play around the brick wall barrier.
- 3. Loitering or standing around is not allowed. We ask that all fans be seated in the stands.
- 4. Absolutely no running, horse playing, pick-up football games, or throwing balls (or other items), etc.
- 5. Students are expected to abide by the Student Code of Conduct while in attendance.
- 6. Fans are not allowed on the track or football field area at any time during the game. Fans wishing to join the team and coaches in the post-game speech should meet them in the end zone area near the scoreboard following the game. This will be the only area of the field made accessible to fans.
- 7. Fans are not allowed to bring food or beverages into the stadium. Concessions are available for your enjoyment.

Fans are reminded that admission to our athletic events is a privilege. With that privilege is the responsibility for fans to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner so that our athletic contest is enjoyable for all fans.
