Rules

- Any official school or community club/organization may enter a float or a vehicle.
- No student shall drive a vehicle in the parade.
- The driver must complete the parade entry form, pay the entry fee, and provide copies of license and proof of insurance before the deadline. Also, give the approximate number of persons planning to ride in the vehicle or on the float.
- No horses, motorcycles, three or four wheelers will be allowed.
- Parade participants must be supervised at all times.
- No candy may be thrown from a float or vehicle.

Other

* ELHS Homecoming Attendants, Band and Senior Float will not be charged.

Parade Line Up Information

Participants will enter the road by the baseball field going to the elementary school off County Road 214. No one will enter from County Road 370 at the Elementary School. Participants should check in at the baseball/softball parking lot and be directed to their place in the line up. **Line up will begin 45 minutes before the parade starts**. If you arrive before this please wait at the baseball/softball field parking lot. If is important that you arrive on time. Any last minute additions to your float/vehicle should be done after you are in position.

Parade Route

The Parade Route will begin on the new road close to the Elementary School. Turn off County Road 214, go by the Elementary School, then turn right onto County Road 370, go in front of the middle school, then turn right again on County Road 214 and end at the football field or the back parking lot at ELHS.
