GETTING STARTED IN YOUR VIRTUAL COURSES

STEP 1: LOG IN USING YOUR USERNAME & PASSWORD

Every student has an unique lowercase username and password.

Your username will usually be your 'firstname.lastname'.

Students with common first and last names (e.g., John Smith, Kathy Jones) may have a two-digit number (e.g., 01, 02...18, etc.) added to the end of their 'firstname.lastname' to make a unique student username for ACCESS.

Username: jane.doe05

A student's password is a combination of their username and their date of birth, entered as usernamemmddyy (where mmddyy is replaced with the student's numeric date of birth). For example:

Username:jane.doe05 Birthday: 12/25/01 Password: jane.doe05122501

STEP 2: COMPLETE THE STUDENT ORIENTATION

You are required to complete the Student Orientation for the 2020-2021 school year ou must earn a score of 90% or higher on the Student Orientation Test **BEFORE** you will see your actual course.

Unlimited test attempts are allowed to meet the minimum score required. It's time to get started.

STEP 3: TIME FOR SUCCESS

A good plan for SUCCESS in online learning often includes these tips:

- S: Start everyday by promptly logging into your online course.
- U: Understand that you must communicate with teachers.
- C: Check your grades
- C: Check your feedback
- E: Examine your News and Pacing Guide that your teacher provides.
- S: Start by completing one to two assignments daily.
- S: Study!
