What might you need to make an appointment to discuss?

To discuss course planning, credit recovery, college requirements, transcript questions, scholarship information, study skill strategies, social/emotional struggles, concerns about another student being harmed or self- harming.

When can you make an appointment?

We prefer that appointments be scheduled before/after school or during your lunch. If it is an emergency, you can ask to see your counselor any time. Emergencies DO NOT INCLUDE: schedule changes, scholarship information, dual enrollment concerns, transcript questions, etc.

Counseling

Why do I need to make an appointment?

Because your counselor may not be available at that moment and you cannot be out of class for long periods of time! In order to meet with as many students as possible, appointments are necessary. If you make an appointment – be sure to show up on time!

Seniors - College Application Season is here! What do you do now?

- 1. Decide which route you are eligible for based on your course history, GPA & test scores.
- 2. Check admission requirements of the colleges/universities you are interested in applying.
- 3. Check the deadlines for applications; make a list or calendar of deadlines
- 4. Complete the online applications
- 5. Take the required tests & have the scores sent directly to the schools. Request scores to be sent if you have already taken the test (a fee may apply).
- 6. Request transcripts and letters of recommendation from your counselor or teachers. Don't wait until the last minutes to ask for letters. Allow at least two weeks! At least one of your letters should come from a core teacher who knows you well.
