It's hard to believe school has already been underway for over a month! I wanted to take a moment to remind all of our families about the importance of good attendance. Parents and caregivers are critical partners in ensuring that children get to school on time and everyday.

- Even excused absences, if allowed to accumulate, can cause children to fall behind.
- Students with good attendance are much more likely to read and do math at grade level.
- If a student is 10 minutes late (or leaves early) to school each day, this adds up to missing more than 33 hours of class time.
- Picking up students early or arriving late can also disrupt the learning of everyone in the class.

What is good attendance? Aim for 97% which means missing no more than 5 days of school. We are here to partner with you and your children every day this year and watch them grow!



3. IF YOU NEED TO VISIT WITH THE TEACHER? You should park.






