
COMMUNITY THEATRE OF LINDEN PRESENTS:

Be exposed to acting by being right on stage!

In the sixth year of this fast-paced workshop, young actors will be provided opportunities to perform and learn important theatre skills. It will culminate with TWO live public performances. Teacher Val Acoba is a credentialed dance and drama instructor who has worked with the Linden after-school recreation program, Kids College at San Joaquin Delta College, Red Dragon Youth Theatre at Confucius Hall in Stockton, and the Stockton Unified School District teaching dance and drama for over 35 years.

The Workshop is scheduled from **June 5-July 1** Monday thru Friday, 10am-12pm; in addition to a MANDATORY Dress Rehearsal on **June 29** from 9:30am to 12pm with two performances on **June 30** (6pm to 9pm) and **July 1** (12pm to 3pm) A tuition of \$125 will be required to participate in this program.

In order to maintain a conducive learning environment, Stage Right students must meet program standards. This includes a "three-day absence" rule. If a student is absent more than three days without a valid excuse, he/she will be dropped from the workshop with NON-REFUNDABLE tuition. Unexcused tardies of more than 15 minutes will not be tolerated. Three or more unexcused tardies will lead to dismissal from the workshop with NON-REFUNDABLE tuition. Good conduct and behavior are required while on the Linden High School campus and at every class meeting. This means courteous attention, good manners, and careful handling of any equipment/props that the student uses. Students must follow the directions given to them by instructors and staff members. Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may result in dismissal from the program with NO REFUND! Parents are responsible for cost of damages incurred by their child either intentionally or through reckless behavior. Students must be picked up immediately at the end of each class session. The Community Theatre of Linden is not responsible for students prior to or after class.
