Native Vision annually gives a \$5,000 college scholarship to outstanding American Indian young people with a commitment to education, athletics, and leadership. Eligibility is dependent on:

- 1. Proof of tribal membership
- 2. Demonstrate a sustained involvement in tribal community and an applied concern for Indigenous issues and initiatives
- 3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher at time of application
- 4. Demonstrate involvement in extracurricular, athletic, and/or learned skills
- 5. Be admitted to an accredited community college or 4 year undergraduate program (fall 2019)
