NHHS sophomores will take the Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT) in science in April. This test is required by the state and will be administered online this year.

Individual results will be provided to students at the beginning of the next school year. Students who achieve goal or higher on the test will earn the distinction of Science CAPT Scholar and have an opportunity to be exempt from science final exams junior year. Details are in the student handbook.

The test window for the Science CAPT begins Monday, April 3, 2017. Students will take the test online during their regularly scheduled Biology classes over two class periods. Each test module lasts 50 minutes, and science teachers have been preparing their students for last few weeks. The school schedule and your student's instructional time in other classes will not be impacted.
