



Required Reading

The required reading book should **be brought to school with them on the first day**.

- 1. A *homework* grade will be issued for bringing the book to class on the first day.
- 2. The scholar will be *quizzed* on the basic knowledge of the book and will receive a **QUIZ** grade on the first day of school. The test will be open-book.
- 3. After completing some classwork assignments, by the end of the first **5 days** of school the scholar will receive a more comprehensive *TEST*.
- 4. The scholar will present their projects on days 5-10 and will receive a *project* grade.

The Assignment

The scholar has until the first 5 days from the first day of school to complete the summer assignment (August 19, 2016). The scholar has six (6) options, but must choose ONE project to complete. The assignment is a PROJECT grade.
