We will be collecting items such as gently worn clothing, shoes, toys, etc. for Goodwill. In turn, Goodwill will be writing a check for \$1,000 (or more depending on how much we collect) to the American Red Cross for items such as food, water, medications, etc. that they are in great need of right now.

For the displaced pets, we are collecting dog and cat food, treats, toys; blankets (can be gently worn and cleaned); hand sanitizer and paper towels. In coordination with the Porter County Animal Shelter, they will be taking all of these items down to Texas and Florida, along with other items they have collected through other drives throughout the county. All pet related items must be bagged separately from clothing
