- Follow the instructions of bus personnel.
- Talk quietly and politely.
- Use language appropriate for the school setting.
- Students must sit in their assigned seat and stay seated while the bus is in motion.
- Be respectful of the rights and safety of others.
- Do not extend head, arms, or objects out of the bus window.
- Keep the bus neat and clean.

Tips for helping your child be a reader at any age!

Model reading. And not on your phone! If you want your child to be a reader, you have to show reading is important to your family. Children follow in their parents footsteps. If they see you reading a book, they are encouraged to read themselves.

Go to the local library and get books. Encourage your child to check out books from the school library. Often gently used books can be purchased at Goodwill. Having books available to read makes it easier for the child to read at home.

Create a reading area. A quiet well-lit place with a pillow or two can create an environment in which your child can enjoy reading. Often our lives are so loud we cannot think. Reading takes time to learn and daily practice to maintain. A quiet place to read is a must!
