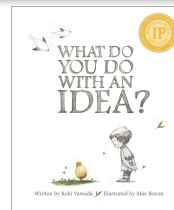

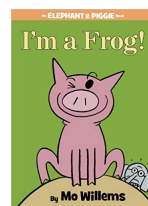

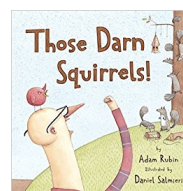
What Are We Reading?
