Friday & Saturday, June 2 & 3	Senior Trip – Moxie Outdoor Adventures White Water Rafting – Departure will be after Class Day. Arrival will be around 6 p.m. on Saturday.
Sunday, June 4	6:00 p.m. – The Senior Banquet will be held at the Franco-American Heritage Center, 46 Cedar Street, Lewiston. Dinner will be a buffet. 7:00 p.m. – Graduation at the Augusta Civic Center in Augusta – All seniors attend. **A minimum of 4 reserved floor seats will be given to each senior.** Additional seating is available for other guests in the stadium seating area.

Seniors in the Music Program are reminded to bring their instruments and music to graduation.

Dress – under caps and gowns (for all functions) females should wear comfortable light colored dress clothing with appropriate footwear. Males wear dress shirt, tie, and suit pants and should wear dress shoes and socks.

Appropriate apparel for graduation exercises will be the traditional cap and gown over appropriate clothing (described above). **No additions to caps and gowns will be allowed unless there is prior approval by the Principal or Assistant Principal. Participation in the ceremony is contingent upon abiding by these rules.**

Please notify your guests of the following requests:

1. Please be considerate when graduates are leaving and remain in your seats until all have left.
2. Children under 6 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
3. Turn off phones and pagers.
4. If you are going to use a video/digital recording device, please be considerate of others around you. **DO NOT OBSTRUCT ANYONE'S VIEW.**
