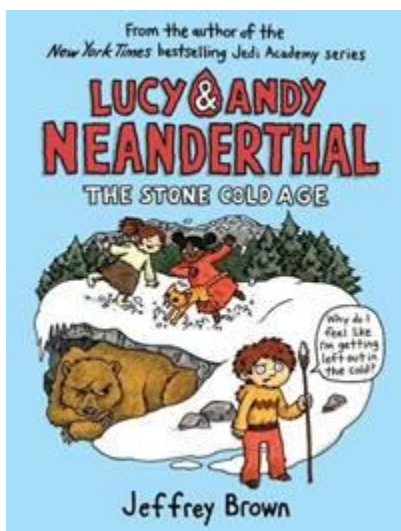
And mark your calendars for our annual Legacy Celebration. Join us for a fun evening of fellowship Friday, November 10, in the Crowley Center.

This is our most popular rewards program, often exceeding several thousand dollars each year. Please check to see if the items you already buy have Box Tops For Education symbols on them. They are worth \$.10 per label!! Clip the Box Tops labels and send them in with your child's name/homeroom teacher.

### AMAZON SMILE

Amazon offers a rewards program but you'll need to sign up. Go to [www.smile.amazon.com](http://www.smile.amazon.com) and sign-in with your usual Amazon user ID and password. You'll be prompted to choose which charity or non-profit organization you want to support. By selecting **St. Augustine Cathedral School in Kalamazoo**, you will be donating .05% of your purchases to our school.

### AUNT MILLIE'S
