RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO IMPOSE AN INCREASE IN LEVIES
EAST GLACIER PARK GRADE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 50
GLACIER COUNTY

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the East Glacier Park Grade School (School District #50) Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The East Glacier Park Grade School Board of Trustees estimates the following changes in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district:

2019-20 projections above are based on the certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year (2018-19), and the State of Montana Office of Public Instruction’s Preliminary Budget Data Sheet posted February 28, 2019. The District’s final certified taxable valuations available August 1, 2019 may result in changes to these estimates.

Regarding the building reserve levy referenced above, the school anticipates inspecting and upgrading school plumbing, and updating the school’s Building Inspection Report. It is expected, but not guaranteed, that the State of Montana’s Office of Public Instruction intends to match these levied funds in the future.
