

## STEAM NEWS

STEAM has been a busy place since coming back from Winter Break! Kindergarten and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade started collecting weather conditions using Floyd's Weather Station and displayed it in graphs to view patterns and trends. Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade have also been discussing space and Earth's movement patterns, discovering how these patterns create day and night and the four seasons. 2<sup>nd</sup> grade has learned about erosion by studying natural disasters, as well as the formation of the Grand Canyon and the Hoover Dam. They even used their engineering skills to build their own dams and then scientifically tested their effectiveness. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade studied rockets and then made and tested own mini versions to learn the physics of balanced and unbalanced forces. 4<sup>th</sup> grade has experimented with many types of energy, including kinetic and sound, learning how energy travels and is transferred. Finally 5<sup>th</sup> grade has used the free online program Scratch <https://scratch.mit.edu/> to learn computer programming, coding their own animation, music videos and games.
