Math & Science Connection

Help your youngster learn about the science of optics with this mealtime activity.

Have him look at himself in a clean spoon. What happens if he looks in the bowl of orange weighs 100 grams, what is the spoon? (He's upside down.) What happens on the other side? *He's right side up.)

Next, have him bring his finger toward the spoon and watch what happens on each side. The bowl (the concave side) will magnify This finger, or make it look larger? The back I(the convex side) will make his finger look Ismaller. Ask your child how scientists might luse this information to make eyeglasses, camera, or telescopes.


Tip: He can remember which side is which by thinking of concave as "caves in"
