Changes to pick up your student(s) must be made in person, in the office or a note with your signature and date sent with your child to school. We WILL NOT make changes over the phone. This is for your student's safety. Changes will not be accepted after 2:00 p.m. Visitor passes are required for anyone who visits our school. To obtain a visitor pass, you must sign in at the office. Student's will be marked truant when the office does not receive a letter or phone call from the parent/guardian within 3 days of an absence. An absence can be a partial or full day of school.

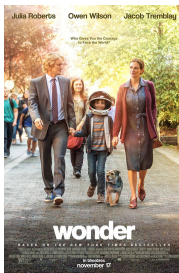
