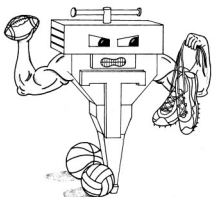
## Please Yield!

## \*\*Attendance\*\*

Students are at risk of being marked truant when a call or written note from a parent/legal guardian is not presented to the school **within three (3) days of an absence**. The definition of an absence includes: a partial or full day absent from school. These types of absences can all be marked truant if contact from the parent/legal guardian is not made within the allowed time limit. If you are taking your child out of school for a trip, you need to fill out the pre-arranged absence forms and return them to the office **at least 2 days before the trip** or the absences are unexcused. These forms may be picked up in the office or printed off from our school website.
