Spring Testing

Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and eats a healthy breakfast

Many teachers report that students who don't do well on tests haven't gotten enough sleep, and haven't eaten breakfast on the morning of the test. Doing both of these things will ensure that your child is working at full capacity.

Make sure your child is prepared

Some schools may supply the tools your child needs for the test, such as pencils, an eraser, paper, and a calculator. Others may require the students to bring those materials themselves. Check with your child's teacher to see if you need to provide your child with any of these materials. Also, check to see whether your child will be able to make up the test if he/she is sick on test day.

Remain positive

Staying calm will help your child stay calm. If he/she gets nervous about the test or is likely to experience anxiety during the test, help him/her practice some relaxation techniques that he/she can try once he's/she's taking the test

Attendance

Students are at risk of being marked truant when a call or written note from a parent/legal guardian is not presented to the school **within three (3) days of an absence.** The definition of an absence includes: a partial or full day absent from school. These types of absences can all be marked truant if contact from the parent/ legal guardian is not made within the allowed time limit. If you are taking your child out of school for a trip, you need to fill out the pre-arranged absence forms and return them to the office **at least 2 days before** the trip or the absences are unexcused. These forms may be picked up in the office or printed off from our school website.
