Kindergarten Registration Begins

The Greenville Area School District will be registering students for Kindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year beginning March 6, 2017. To be eligible for Kindergarten, a child must be 5 years of age by September 1, 2017. Registration packets can be picked up in the offices at both Hempfield and East Elementary Schools beginning March 6, 2017. Packets may also be downloaded from the district website at www.greenville.k12.pa.us

Completed registration packets, along with copies of the child's birth certificate, immunization record and proofs of residency, can be returned to Hempfield Elementary on April 4, 5 or 6, 2017. On April 4 and 6, 2017, packets can be dropped off from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM. On April 5, packets may be dropped off 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM or from 3:30 PM to 5:30 PM. Appointments for Kindergarten screening will be scheduled when the packets are returned to the school.

Third Grade Collecting Recyclable Aluminum Cans

The Third Grade classrooms will be collecting recyclable cans from now until Earth Day on April 22. Those wanting to contribute should bring their cans to school and place them in any of the bins located throughout the hallways at Hempfield Elementary. 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th Grade Students to Complete PSSA

Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth grade students will be taking the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) in English Language Arts

on April 3, 4, 5 and 6, 2017. The PSSA Math assessment will be given April 24, 25 and 26, 2017. Testing sessions will be completed in the morning of each day from 9:15 AM to approximately 12 noon.

All students in grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 must participate in the assessment. It is very important that all students be present during testing. We also encourage all students get a good night's sleep prior to testing. It is also important that your child eat breakfast each day during the PSSA testing.
