End of School Year Adjustment Reminder

Dress Code Reminder

Please be aware of the following dress code requirements. These requirements apply to both East and Hempfield Elementary Schools. Shorts and skirts must be fingertip length with the student's arm fully extended. Tank tops, halter tops, crop tops or sleeveless shirts are not to be worn. In addition, shirts that reveal a child's mid-section are not permitted. Appropriate footwear must be worn. Sandals, backless shoes, and flip-flops may be worn at the risk of the individual. The district is not responsible for any potential injuries that may occur as a result of footwear. Bedroom slippers are not permitted. Students who violate the dress code will be given a warning and asked to call home for different clothes. Repeated violations may result in the issuing of disciplinary consequences.
