Educational Trips and Vacations

For a maximum of five school days per school year, the district will grant excused absences from school for trips/vacations having educational value as determined by both the Principal and Superintendent. Approval will not be granted for trips scheduled during the last ten days of the school year, and the PSSA testing windows of April 9 - 13, 2018 and April 16 - 20, 2018. Absences exceeding the approved five days will be considered unlawful/unexcused.

The required approval form is available in the main office and must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the scheduled trip. Permission may be denied by the administration for the following reasons: poor academic standing, poor attendance, and/or disciplinary factors. 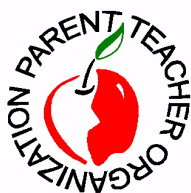
