Parent Volunteer Guidelines

Parents are encouraged to volunteer in our classrooms. All prospective volunteers are required to complete the volunteer screening process and be approved by the school board prior to volunteer service. Volunteer requirements include:

- Act 34 (Child Abuse) and 151 (State Police Report) clearances are required. Both clearances are free of charge to parent volunteers.
- Copies of clearances must be given to the building secretary who will forward them to the superintendent's office for approval by the school board

Additionally, parents wishing to become a booster club or PTO officer must obtain an FBI background check in addition to the Act 34 and 151 clearances.

If you have previously been approved as a volunteer, please be aware that volunteer clearances expire every five years. Approved volunteers with clearances that are over five years old will not be permitted to participate in field trips, classroom parties, special events during school and/or help out in the classroom.

Parent Lunches with Students

Parents wishing to eat lunch with their child at school must inform their child's teacher at least 24 hours in advance. Please also be aware that only one lunch per nine week grading period may be scheduled.
