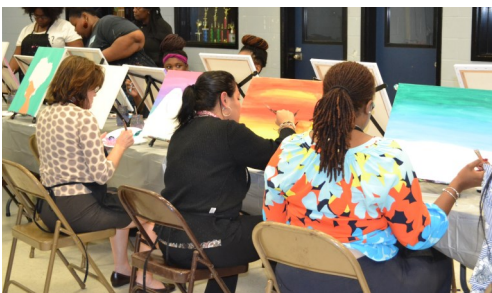


## Black History Celebration

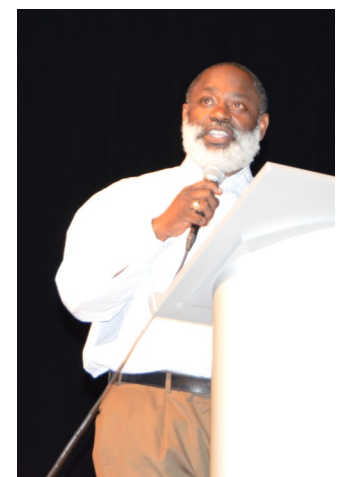

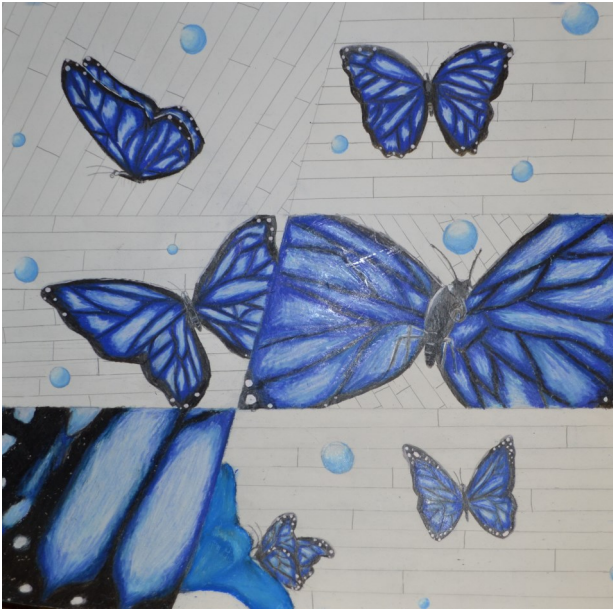

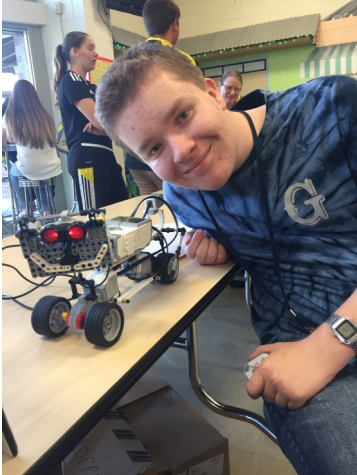
### Varsity Girls' Basketball Playoff Bound

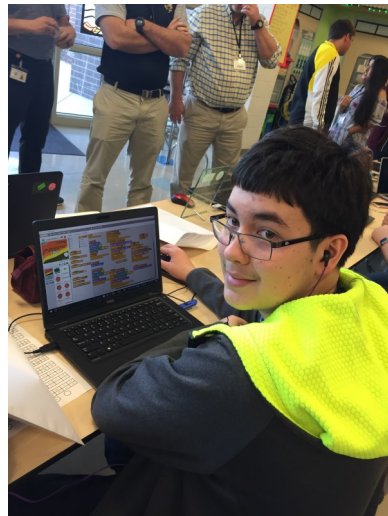
