Behavior Number System

Our behavior number system that is used in classrooms focuses on students making good decisions and being responsible for their actions. If your child receives a 4 or higher for the day, then this is considered a good day! The connection from school to home is important, so we are asking for you to praise your child if they get a 4 or higher for the day. Students rarely get a 7 because that means they have done something extraordinary that day. Thank you for working with us as we continue to acknowledge and encourage positive behavior.


School Pictures
