### CAP AND GOWN ATTIRE FOR PICTURES, BACCALAUREATE, AND COMMENCEMENT CEREMONIES

All students will wear their graduation cap and gowns for these three events. You must wear the following under your cap and gown:

<u>Females:</u> Church dress that complies with the school dress code; BLACK dress shoes (NO FLIP FLOPS); do not wear the white collar that comes with the robe

<u>Males:</u> Dark <u>navy or black dress slacks</u> (NO JEANS OR KHAKIS); white dress shirt; dark, navy, or black <u>PLAIN</u> tie; black dress shoes, dark socks (NO FLIP FLOPS OR TENNIS SHOES)

- No decorations of any kind will be allowed on caps or gowns.
- Only Newberry School District approved/issued cords and stoles may be worn.

#### DRESS CODE FOR SENIOR NIGHT

The clothing you wear under your cap and gown is appropriate for senior night. Jeans, shorts, tshirts, etc. will not be allowed – students not dressed appropriately will not be allowed to participate.


Females: Church dress that complies with school dress code - no short skirts or short rompers

Males: Dress pants, shirt AND tie

Students are expected to dress exceptionally nice. All seniors should be lined up by 5:45. Doors will be locked at 6 p.m. and no one else will be admitted.
