Drop Off, Pick Up and Volunteering

Parents,

We need your help with drop off in the mornings, pick up in the afternoons and volunteering. Since we are beginning the second semester, we believe that every student is secure enough to be dropped off in the mornings in the car rider line. They should be able to walk in independently and go to breakfast or sit in the cafeteria. In the afternoons, we encourage each family of K-5th graders to wait in the car rider line for their student. When we have a lot of parents standing in the hallways at dismissal, the risk increases that a child will end up in the wrong place. We are trying to keep all of our students safe. Also, if you would like to volunteer for your child's teacher, please do so prior to 2:00PM. Come to the office and sign in on the volunteer log and get a volunteer badge. When you finish volunteering, please sign out and return the badge to the office. After 2:00PM, you will need approval to enter the building to volunteer. If you are in the building after 3:00pm, you will need to go to the workroom and wait until the buses leave for the day before you can leave with your student. Please help us to keep all students safe.
