Scholarships are open to:

- Graduating high school seniors enrolled in or registered with the White Pass School District (home school students must be registered with Intent to Home School letter on file with the White Pass School District),
- with a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.0,
- who submit a complete application packet by the deadline of 8:00 am, March 18, 2019
- and who participate in an interview with members of the scholarship committee.
- **Note:** Application for scholarship does not guarantee an award.

White Pass Scholarship Application Packet Checklist

- **Application Form** – Complete, signed and dated. You can complete this four-page form electronically or in your own handwriting. If completed electronically, you must print, sign and submit a paper document. Scholarship applications are available as a PDF fillable form on the White Pass High School website (www.whitepass.k12.wa.us).
- **Transcript** – DO NOT include your transcript. Your signature on the application authorizes the WPSF Committee to obtain your high school transcript.
- **Personal letter**, typed – 2 page maximum
Letter must include but is not limited to:
 1. Reflection on how your life experiences have influenced you.
 2. Educational goals and field of study you are considering and why.
 3. Statement on financial need and/or special circumstances. Include familial or guardian support or challenges for your past and future educational goals.

NOTE: We will judge applicants in the following six categories: 1) grades and academic achievement; 2) commitment to educational goals; 3) community service; 4) financial need and special circumstances; 5) school, work and community activities; 6) presentation of self. You should make sure you address these categories in your application. Scoring low in a particular area will not take you out of the running to receive a scholarship award.
