WHAT DOES THE P.T.O. DO????

For the Early Childhood Center and Elementary school, we...

- ✓ Organize Senior VIP Day (Grandparent's Day); provide refreshments and paper products for each classroom (October)
- ✓ Choose Panther Parents and Head Room Parents for grades K-4; collect and distribute party money (Sept.)
- ✓ DNA swabbing at the Early Childhood Center (and new students at the Elementary) in the Fall

For the Elementary School, we...

- ✓ Staff the school supply cart at Elementary School every Monday morning (7:30 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.)

For the Middle School, we...

- ✓ Provide \$2,000 annually for the fifth grade field trip to Springfield (total cost: over \$10,000)
- ✓ Choose Head Room Parents for 5th grade; collect and distribute party money (Sept.)

For the High School, we...

- ✓ Provide two \$500 scholarships to graduating seniors

For ALL Four Schools, we...

- ✓ Provide and serve refreshments at open houses at Elementary and Middle Schools (August)
- ✓ Collect orders for school supply kits (K-8); purchase items and assemble kits ourselves to save parents money; distribute kits in August
- ✓ Organize lunch for over 170 teachers and staff during Teacher Appreciation Week in May at three schools
- ✓ Administer Staples Reward Program – By recycling personal and commercial ink cartridges, we receive vouchers from Staples, and then purchase much-needed supplies for teachers as requested on an ongoing basis.

We also distribute funds raised from various fundraisers to teachers who present their requests for special projects or items they use in the classroom.

We have provided funds in the past to purchase Promethean Boards and technology for many classrooms, a yearly subscription to Brain Pop, Jr. (used at the Elem. School), and Brain Pop (used at the Middle School), novels, classroom dictionaries, butterfly kits for the 4th graders, IKAN Life Education Center for all 4th graders, a 71005C Watershed/Enviroscape, a Disability Awareness Workshop Fee, Scholastic Math Magazines, flexible seating, educational carpets, science equipment, and so much more!
