

## Dunbar Magnet 2017-2018 Uniform Policy

<u>Girls' Tops</u>	<u>Boys' Tops</u>
Shirts- Different for each grade. See below. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 8<sup>th</sup> Grade- White knit polo shirt</li> <li>• 7<sup>th</sup> Grade- White knit polo shirt</li> <li>• 6<sup>th</sup> Grade- Red <i>knit polo shirt</i></li> </ul>	Shirts- Different for each grade. See below. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 8<sup>th</sup> Grade- White knit polo shirt</li> <li>• 7<sup>th</sup> Grade- White knit polo shirt.</li> <li>• 6<sup>th</sup> Grade- Red <i>knit polo shirt</i></li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shirts may be short or long sleeve.</li> <li>• Shirts must be loose fitting, two buttoned, no cleavage.</li> <li>• Undershirts must be solid white. No P.E. shirts or shirts with emblems, writing, or color under uniform shirts.</li> <li>• Shirts must be neat and tucked in at all times (not rolled under).</li> </ul>	
<u>Girls' Bottoms</u>	<u>Boys' Bottom</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Navy uniform pants (No leggings or jeggings)</li> <li>• Navy knee length shorts</li> <li>• Navy or Dunbar plaid skirts, no A-line (fitted).</li> <li>• Skirts must not be shorter than 4 inches in front or back when measured kneeling.</li> <li>• Shorts must be worn under skirts at all times. <b>NO SKORTS!</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Navy Pants</li> <li>• Navy knee length shorts.</li> </ul>
No sagging pant, low cut waistlines, or tight pants. Pants must be worn at the natural waistline; belt loops must be visible at all times.	
<u>Belts, Shoes and Socks</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Belt -Solid navy or black belt only, <i>no designs of any kind</i>, plain buckle.</li> <li>• Shoes- Solid black lace up or Velcro, leather or canvas tennis shoes, <i>no slip on shoes or rain boots</i>, no colors no exceptions.</li> <li>• Socks- Solid white or black socks, crew or ankle socks, <i>must be visible</i>.</li> </ul>	
<u>Outerwear</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Navy or red button or zip jacket, button up sweater, or sweatshirt without hood may be worn in class, <b><i>NO HOODED SWEATSHIRT FOR NEW STUDENTS.</i></b> 8<sup>th</sup> grade students may continue to wear the Dunbar sweatshirts purchased during a previous year. Hooded sweatshirts will be phased out. All non-uniform jackets must be removed and placed in locker prior to homeroom.</li> <li>• <i>NO out of -uniform jackets will be allowed in classrooms.</i></li> <li>• Dunbar jackets, sweatshirts and t-shirts will be sold during the fall.</li> </ul>	
<u>Tights</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid white or navy tights, <i>with feet</i>, may be worn. <i>NO leggings.</i></li> </ul>	
<u>Ribbons/Head Coverings</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must match school colors or grade level shirt: solid white, solid navy, solid red and solid black. Ribbons should not reach below the neck. Headbands must be worn in the hair, NOT on the forehead. The same colors required for headbands. No hats indoors.</li> </ul>	
<u>Make- Up, Fingernails and Hair</u>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make-up should be minimal. Fingernail length should not interfere with use of educational tools and if polished, color should be clear or neutral. Hair should have a traditional, conservative cut and style and have a natural human color. <i>No Red, Blue, Green, Pink, Purple or unnatural color allowed.</i></li> </ul>
