


OIS is College and Career Ready

EDUCATIONAL STRATEGIES

Our main focus will be reading and math, therefore, the CIP team created and implemented the following strategies in order to raise scores in math and reading.

1. All core teachers begin class with student friendly objectives.
2. All students will have time to assess and reflect on lessons with teachers implementing strategic teaching.
3. Higher order questioning and reflecting
4. Small group instruction and long range lesson planning
5. Authentic reading, math, and writing lessons.
6. Technology integration and open ended responses
7. Reading and writing across multiple genres
8. Progress monitoring, strategic teaching, differentiated instruction, inquiry-based lessons
9. Problem solving strategies, incentive programs, explicit phonics instruction, and multisensory language
10. Read 180 and System 44
11. Book Whisperer strategies implemented in library and classroom settings.
12. Multiple transition strategies between OES and OMS.
