DRESS CODE

Good appearance, good attitudes, and good grooming add to the effectiveness of a student in school and are very conducive to a good learning environment. Students are expected to attend school in neat, clean, appropriate clothing and their bodies covered. The following rules are intended to define appropriate student attire and personal grooming. Parents are expected to enforce the dress code standards before the children leave for school each morning. This will allow the school to fully concentrate on the educational development of every child in the District.

If a student is in violation of the dress code they will allowed to call home and have appropriate clothing brought to them at school. However, students will be required to change into their P.E. clothes and must return to class until a change of clothes arrive. In areas not covered by the dress code, the onsite administrator shall make judgments at their own discretion.

1. No torn clothing that exposes skin.
2. No spandex.
3. **No sagging pants.**
4. No un-hemmed garments.
5. No mid-sections showing.
6. **No spaghetti straps, tank tops, or muscle t-shirts.**
7. No undergarments showing.
8. No pajamas.
9. No leggings worn as pants.
10. No vulgar, racial, or inappropriate graphics on garments.
11. No low cut dresses or blouses.
12. No flip flops/slippers/backless shoes.
13. No distracting haircuts (such as mohawks).
14. **Students are discouraged from coloring their hair unnatural colors, i.e. green, blue, pink, etc. without prior administrative approval.**
15. No pierced body parts other than ears.
16. No studs, spikes, or stud accessories.
17. No hats, bandanas or sunglasses inside the building.
18. No writing on bodies or clothes.
