

M-CHS LOCKOUT DRILL

Montezuma-Cortez High School is conducting a school-wide lockout DRILL on Thursday afternoon, April 5.

No emergency or threat exists at this time, and no schools other than the high school are involved.

The drill will begin at approximately 2:15 p.m. Thursday. M-CHS staff and students will be evacuated by law enforcement to the high school auditorium to meet with Principal Jason Wayman.

The drill will conclude by the end of the regular school day, and no parent pickup will be necessary.

The purpose of the drill is to evaluate emergency operations plans, practice response skills, and prepare students, staff, the school safety team, local law enforcement, first responders and fire personnel to work together effectively to implement safety plans. Drills are scheduled throughout the school year, and the results are used to refine safety plans and design future drills.
