Important Dates

12/12/16 – Students in grades 10 and 11 can access PSAT/NMSQT score reports online.

12/14/16 – Students in grade 9 can access PSAT 8/9 score reports online.

12/19/16 – Student advisory for grades 9, 10, and 11. Students will receive their PSAT question booklet, information on how to access their scores, and information on how to link their score to Khan Academy to begin free, personalized SAT preparation.

1/9/17 – Parents and students in grades 9, 10, and 11 are invited to join us for an information session at 6:30 in the North Haven High School Theater. Topics will include accessing scores, understanding your PSAT report, and how to link scores to Khan Academy for personalized practice.

4/5/17 – Students in grade 11 take the SAT during the school day.

How to Access Your Scores

- 1. Log in to an existing College Board account or create a new one at studentscores.collegeboard.org
- 2. Select PSAT/NMSQT Scores (PSAT 8/9 if you are a 9th grader) or –
- 3. Select "Missing Scores" to locate scores

How to Link to Khan Academy (for more information and a free personalized study plan)

- 1. Log in or create a free Khan Academy Account satpractice.org
- 2. Agree to link your Khan Academy and College Board account (You will then be directed to collegeboard.org)
- 3. Sign in or create a College Board Account
- 4. When prompted; hit "Send" to authorize the account linking
- 5. Start practicing on Official SAT practice on Khan Academy!
