



## **IF YOUR CHILD IS SICK...**

### **PLEASE FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE RULES TO HELP INSURE THE HEALTH OF ALL STUDENTS AND STAFF AND TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF SICKNESS**

#### **FEVERS:**

Students should stay home if their temperature is 100 degrees or higher. They must be kept home until they have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-controlling medicine. Fever-controlling medicines include aspirin, acetaminophen (Tylenol), ibuprofen (Advil and Motrin), and Aleve. Aspirin should not be used in children under the age of 20 without Doctor's advice

#### **ANTIBIOTICS**

Students may return to school 24 hours after antibiotics have been started and when they have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-controlling medicine.

#### **DIARRHEA**

Students must be without diarrhea for 24 hours without the use of antidiarrheal medicines before returning to school.

#### **VOMITING**

Students must be without vomiting for 24 hours without the use of any antiemetic (such as phenergan) before returning to school.
