



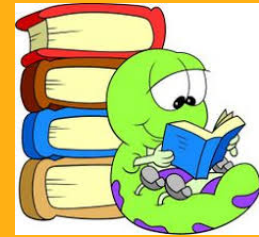

What does "comprehension" in reading mean?

To understand reading comprehension, you must go beyond reading the words on a page. It involves finding meaning in the text and being able to summarize, reiterate, and apply what has been read. Successful reading comprehension requires text comprehension, vocabulary knowledge, and reading fluency. If your child cannot recognize and understand the individual words on a page, then he or she will struggle to make sense of the text as a whole. Students with well-developed comprehension skills are able to understand both the main idea and the details of any given text, and they are able to identify the different components of the text as well. Comprehension is an interactive process that occurs while students are reading and after reading as well. Comprehension is a skill that has to be taught to students and reinforced over an extended period of time to ensure that your child can master the skill.
