Dear Parents,

Students in Georgia took the Georgia Milestones End of Course Assessment in April/May 2017. Attached you will find your child's Georgia Student Growth Model (GSGM) Report. This report provides information on your child's progress during the 2016 – 2017 school year. This report provides you with Student Growth Percentiles (SGPs). SGPs indicate how much growth your child showed relative to other students across the state of Georgia that were similar to him/her academically.

Student Growth Percentiles range from 1 to 99. The higher the percentile, the greater the growth. A SGP of 64 means that the student grew more than 64% of his/her academically similar peers and that 36% of his/her academically similar peers showed more growth than him/her.

In this report, you will find an interpretive guide that will provide information to help you understand the growth reports for each of the content areas. Also included is a FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) document.

GSGM reports are also found in the State Longitudinal Data System (SLDS). Parents can log into Infinite Campus Parent Portal and click the SLDS link for statewide tests and student attendance.
