CHMS END OF YEAR REMINDERS: SIXTH and SEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS ~ Final Exams & Olympic Events

Dear Wildcat Parents and Students.

We know that our students are excited about the final days of school (Now until May 25)!!!

Beginning with Monday, May 21st through Friday, May 25th, all students will have **FINAL EXAMS** and several special events.

Attendance for the last week of school is VERY IMPORTANT as final exams will be completed at this time!

Please see the following reminders regarding the last week of school.

- No bookbags, large gym bags or drawstring bags are allowed on campus after Friday, May 18th.
- Teachers will have students clean out their lockers by Friday, May 18th.
- For your student's Olympic Day (he/she will be outside from 8:45 until 12:00), the following procedures apply:
 - No gym bags or drawstring bags may be used. If your student needs a bag in which to transport items, a
 small disposable plastic or an open-topped recycled grocery bag should be used.
 - Students may bring a towel to sit upon, sunscreen and one drink to consume outside. It is helpful if you write your student's name on the towel to avoid it being lost. Students should bring water or a sports drink (such as Gatorade). No carbonated drinks are allowed. All drinks must be in a <u>plastic bottle</u> with a sealed lid.
 - No sunglasses or hats may be worn inside the gym or inside the school building
 - NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES should be brought to CHMS the final week of school!!!!
- Olympic days: Eighth= Monday, May 21 Seventh= Tuesday, May 22 Sixth= Wednesday, May 23
- A Snow Cone truck (Kona Ice) will be at CHMS on May 21, 22, 23. Students might want to bring a few dollars (\$4-\$6) to enjoy a snow cone during the Olympics! Note: all proceeds made from the Kona Ice truck will go towards Student and Teacher incentives at CHMS.
- We are unable to permit Parents/Visitors to the Olympic events due to limited seating and safety precautions.
- Thursday (May 24) and Friday (May 25) are both <u>Half Days</u>. Car Riders will be released at 12:20 / Bus Riders will be released beginning at 12:30 p.m.
- Students should be reminded that we **DO NOT** write on any clothing worn to school and the dress code still applies during Olympic week.

Parents, please note that **FINAL EXAMS** will be averaged into your student's grade and the final report card will be $\underline{\text{mailed home}}$ on June 4th.

All students must have lunch fines, book fines and library fines paid in order to have their report card mailed home.

All agenda books will be turned in and collected by the Homeroom teacher on May 25th.
