Important Information

- AP Test Registration is open from Sept. 18, 2017 to March 2, 2018.
- All tests must be ordered and paid for by **March 2, 2018 at 2 pm** (no exceptions).
- Payments can be made in cash (exact amount only), money order or checks.
- Please use one form and make one payment for all exams.

Exam Fees

Exams ordered by Oct. 27 - \$65 per test

Exams ordered by Dec. 15 - \$75 per test

Exams ordered by March 2 - \$85 per test

STEM Free Exam

- **STEM students get one free exam this year -
Calculus AB, Computer Science Principles,
Statistics, Chemistry**

Reduced Testing Fee

- **No waivers** for free exams are available this year.
- Students who qualify and have applied for free/reduced lunch this year **pay only \$53** for each exam they take.
- Applications must be approved through the lunch room **before** registering for your exam.

Testing Day

- **Only required to attend exam on day of testing, no regular classes**
- **Bring pencils, pen, erasers, calculator (if allowed), jacket.**
- **Do not bring – food, drinks, notes, books, cellphones, electronic devices**

Off-site Testing



- Most exams will be given at Georgia Highlands College – no bus transportation will be available.
- You will need to provide your own transportation to and from the testing site.

Don't Be Late!

- ALL EXAMS WILL BEGIN AT 8 a.m. or 12 p.m. **SHARP.**
- If you arrive late, you will not be allowed to take the exam, exam fees are non-refundable.
- *Make-up* sessions must be registered for in advance, late testing fee is \$45.
