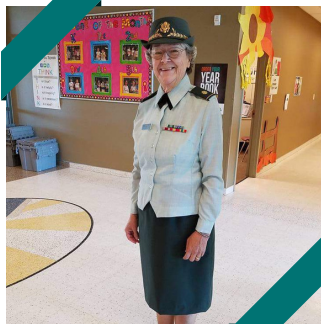
T-Shirts may be purchased in the Library for \$10 each. Sizes are available from Child Small to Child XL.
