---REMINDER---

Changes to pick up your student(s) must be made in person, in the office or a note with your signature and date sent with your child to school. We WILL NOT make changes over the phone. This is for your student's safety. Changes will not be accepted after 2:00 p.m. Once the bell has rang we CAN NOT pull your student off the bus. Students can not be picked up early after 3:00 p.m. If a student needs to be pulled out early for any reason please do so before 3:00 p.m. You will have to meet your student(s) at the bus stop. Visitor passes are required for anyone who visits our school. To obtain a visitor pass, you must sign in at the office. Student's will be marked truant when the office does not receive a letter, phone call, or email from the parent/guardian within 3 days of an absence.
