- ❖ *To become familiar with the purpose of the ACT Assessment.*
- ❖ *To emphasize study in English, mathematics, reading, science and test-taking skills.*

This course is designed to prepare high school students for the four sections tested on the ACT Assessment by covering test taking strategies, pacing oneself, using logic, reviewing your answers, etc. Students will work on areas, techniques, and skills that need improving before taking the ACT test. Participants will not be taught more English, Mathematics, Reading or Science. Preliminary tests will be given in each of the four areas for diagnostic purposes.
