

Review of Inclement Weather

With our erratic weather patterns, we must have a plan for early dismissal of our students. I hope that you did sign the Inclement Weather form and return it to your child's teacher relating to us what you want your child to do in case of early dismissal. Please let us know if there are changes to the plan you gave us at the beginning of the school year.

One of my biggest concerns is the flow of traffic. When the decision is made to call school off due to weather conditions our dismissal plan is just like any other day. The students will be sent to the gym, numbers will be called and your child will be dismissed to you. It is dangerous to have cars coming from the front of the school and trying to merge into the flow of traffic leaving the school. I am asking that you get in the pickup line instead of coming in to get your child. I do understand emergencies, and if that is the case, by all means, feel free to come in to pick them up.

Practices for tornado watches and warnings are done often. The children know what to do when these warnings and watches are in force. You may pick your child up during the tornado watch, but once the tornado watch becomes a warning students will not be dismissed. Please know that you can come to school and stay with your child if you are concerned about their safety during the warning.
