



Program Applicants:

Upcoming high school juniors and seniors may apply for a two day Aspiring Nurses camp which will be held on June 25 & 26. This camp is geared around skills for students considering a career in nursing. Students will have the opportunity to receive sessions on patient confidentiality, vital signs, sterile technique, health assessment, CPR, infection control, obstetrical care, and hands on experiences with a high fidelity simulator along with many more topics. Camp attendees will have the opportunity to meet ACON faculty and students. A tour of the campus and residence halls will also be included. The Anderson College of Nursing and Health Professions will accept the first forty (40) applicants for this event. Students will learn about the Early Admission option, Project Open, Study Abroad, and the Student Nurses Association. The **deadline** to apply is **May 5**. The Aspiring Nurses camp is scheduled on a first come first serve basis. This will be a wonderful opportunity to learn or refine basic patient care skills.

Dress:

All participants will receive a UNA Anderson College of Nursing and Health Professions t-shirt upon arrival to the camp. Khaki pants are preferred as professional attire.

Tuition Fees:

There is a **\$50.00** cost to attend the Aspiring Nurses camp. Make checks payable to the UNA Anderson College of Nursing and Health Professions. The fee should be mailed in with the camp application. Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided. Students and chaperones will walk downtown to a local restaurant for supper on June 25. Students will need to bring money for this meal.
