

Intent to Enroll for 2013-2014 School Year

Please complete this Intent to Enroll form for each student who would like to attend Orcutt Academy High School

The Orcutt Academy Charter School will open its doors in August 2013 to students in grades K-12. The enrollment window opens on **Monday, November 5, 2012, and closes at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 5, 2013.** If enrollment is oversubscribed, an enrollment lottery will be used to select students. This lottery will be held at the Orcutt Academy High School Multi-Use Room at **7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2013.** All prospective enrollees and their families are invited to witness the lottery. The results of the lottery will be posted on the school website; parents who would prefer for their child's name not to be posted should contact Director of Charter Programs Joe Dana at 938-8934.

For Orcutt Academy High School (OAHS), admission will follow five steps. (1) Graduates of the Orcutt Academy's K-8 campus will matriculate to OAHS provided they meet admissions requirements. (2) Immediately prior to the enrollment lottery on February 6, 2013, preferential enrollment will be granted first to student applicants whose parents served on the initial charter steering/advisory committee, children of Orcutt Academy staff, and siblings of current Orcutt Academy students. (3) Preferential enrollment next will be granted to applicants who are residents of the Orcutt Union School District. If enrollment is oversubscribed, a separate drawing for district residents only will be conducted to identify who become candidates for admission and the sequential order of the wait list. (4) After district residents are considered, an enrollment lottery will be held for all other applicants to the high school. (5) Students are not officially admitted to OAHS until completion of admissions requirements (2.0 grade point average or higher in core subjects in eighth grade and readiness to take High School Algebra I or higher in math in ninth grade) can be verified and the necessary paperwork completed. Once a student is admitted, he or she will be considered an ongoing student of OAHS until he or she graduates, withdraws, or leaves the school.

I further understand that student enrollment selection through the lottery is not final until each student submits proof of meeting high school admissions requirements (2.0 grade point average or higher in core subjects in eighth grade and readiness to take High School Algebra I or higher in math in ninth grade) **and** other final registration requirements. Finally, I declare under penalty of perjury that all information provided is truthful to the best of my knowledge. I understand that, if any of the information provided on this form is determined to be false, my student's enrollment spot may be forfeited.
